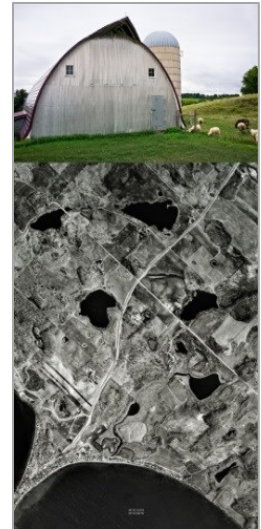

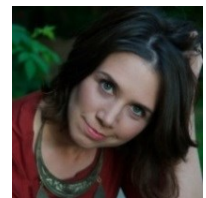
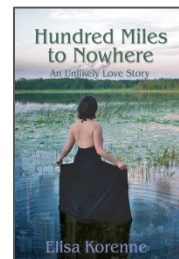
Book Launch with Author Elisa Korene

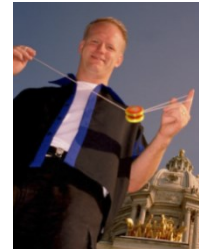
